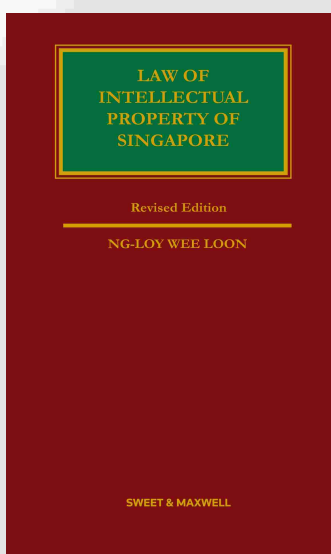

- ▲ the IP story of Singapore: how its IP infrastructure grew from the early days of nationhood in 1965 to reach its current 'TRIPS-plus' status
- ▲ the substantive law relating to the IP rights (e.g. the criteria for its subsistence; ownership; infringement; defences; enforcement; commercial exploitation)

The book pays particular focus to cases decided by Singapore courts. Comprising of 44 chapters, this book is written in a style and structured in a manner which is easily understood and digested.

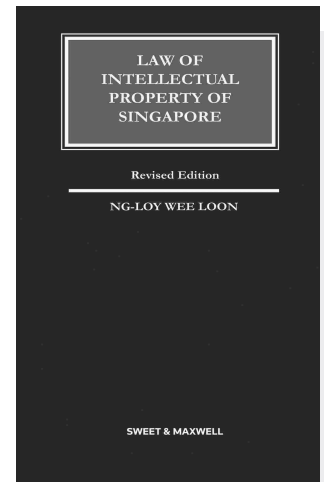
